

Entry and Indoor Parking Guidelines for Legend, Vintage, and BowTie Classes.

These guidelines are necessary due to the lack of parking available in “Y Building”. There are nineteen (19) parking spaces in “Y Building”. These spaces will be divided between the Legend and Vintage Classes as equally as possible. Once “Y Building” is full your Legend or Vintage class car will either be parked outside, or in your trailer, and you will be advised when to bring you car into “Y Building” for review.

Legends

New entrants to the classes will be accepted as follows; cars that have gone through BowTie Legends Class and are approved for Legends Class will have until February 1st of each show year to send in their entries and completed prequalification sheets. Both must be received to be considered a complete entry. If a BowTie Legends approved entry is received after that date, it will be grouped with all other Legends entries. Entrants who had their car approved by a Legends judge; their entries and completed pre-qualifications sheets will be received from February 2nd until the class closing date or the class is full. No more than five (5) new cars will be accepted in any year unless there is room in the class and approved by the American Camaro Association and the Legends Concours judges.

Second and third time entrants will be accepted on an entry date format until the closing date for the class. The Legend class limit is a maximum of ten (10) returning cars. Legends entrants returning for their third review you will not be guaranteed a parking space in “Y Building”. Third time entries take a minimum amount of time to re-judge. Free trailer parking will be included with your Concours entry. If parking is available in “Y Building” it will be determined by date of entry.

Vintage

Vintage entries will be received on an entry date format.

“Y- Building” Space Allotment

Suggested parking space per class is as follows; First Gen Legends will be nine (9) cars, Second Gen Legends and Vintage will have five spaces each. Cars must be parked in their assigned spaces by Noon on Friday. Parking spaces can be adjusted as needed. Parking is tight and all entrants are entitled to an equal amount of space. Display signs must be kept to a minimum as well as chairs and other personal items. Any one taking advantage of their allotted space will be asked to correct the area or will be asked to remove their car from the building.

BowTie Class

BowTie Class First Generation will receive entries as follows; the class limit is fifteen (15) cars, this includes both BowTie and BowTie Legends. BowTie Legends will be limited to five (5) cars; once the class limit has been reached all other entries will be returned. Second and Third Generation BowTie entrants will have no limit until such time as it is necessary. All cars must be parked with their class to be judged; judges will not go looking for your car.
